INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT SIBIU

- Formerly the centre of the Transylvanian Saxons, the old city of Sibiu was ranked as "Europe's 8th most idyllic place to live" by Forbes.
- ► Sibiu's Bridge of Liars is Romania's oldest cast iron bridge, which replaced a wooden bridge in 1859. The bridge got its name from the legend that if you told a lie and tried to cross the bridge, you would die instantly.
- ▶ Paltiniş is the highest resort in Romania (1440 m altitude), 35 kilometers south-west from Sibiu.
- ▶ The Brukenthal Museum is the first Romanian museum, and is also the oldest museum in Central and Eastern Europe.
- ▶ The Sibiu Pharmacy Museum is housed in a 1569 Gothic townhouse in the Little Square, in the location where the oldest pharmacy in Romania operated for over 150 years.
- ► Pasajul Scărilor, the Stairs Passageway, is one of the most picturesque places in Sibiu. It connects the Lower Town to the Upper Town and was built in 13th century. It is lined with some of Sibiu's oldest buildings including the oldest restaurant in Romania, Butoiul de Aur, the Golden Barrel.
- Around Sibiu, in Ocna Sibiului, there's a curious place to visit: the salted ponds of a former salt mine now used for therapeutical baths by local people. The landscape and the ambiance is strange due to the ponds digged like little volcano craters.
- ▶ The presence of the fortified churches dating from the 12th 16th century is characteristic for Sibiu. The fortified churches are a unique and very interesting phenomenon. Some of them (7 to be more precise) were declared heritage monuments and are now included on the UNESCO list (Biertan, Viscri, Saschiz, Prejmer, Valea Viilor, Calnic and Darjiu).



SIBIU – EUROPEAN CAPITAL OF CULTURE 2007



Situated in the central part of Romania at the pediment of the Carpathian Mountains, Sibiu is one of the best preserved medieval citadels of Transylvania, still displaying the Germanic atmosphere, culture and lifestyle that has been here ever since its foundation.

HOW TO GET THERE



The air connections of the city are insured by the Sibiu International Airport, located on national road DN1, at 3 kilometers from the city. Direct connections with the international airports in Bucharest, Targul Mureş and Timişoara, and with the international airports in Germany, Spain, Ukraine, Austria, Moldavia Greece and Italy, by means of regular flights.

Airlines with service to Sibiu: Austrian Airlines(Vienna), Luthansa(Munich), Tarom(Bucharest/Otopeni, Munich) and Blue Air(Bucharest/Baneasa, Stuttgart)



Sibiu is passed by two major European roads: E 68 (Arad - Sibiu - Brasov) and E 81 (Cluj - Sibiu - Pitesti - Bucuresti)

BY TRAIN

- From Bucharest there are 2 trains daily to Sibiu (one in the morning, one in the night)
- From Cluj-Napoca, the main city of Transylvania, there are 2 fairly convenient trains a day, taking around 3,5h. (More info on: www.infofer.ro)
